We are pleased to provide you with the following information regarding Noma2's experience with Hie Electronics and the TeraStack Solution:

1) Product Selection and History of Noma2/Hie Electronics Cooperation

Hie Electronics and the TeraStack Solution was highly recommended by L-3 engineers. After having analyzed the product capability and opportunity for cooperation, on January 05, 2010 Noma2 and Hie Electronics signed a Value-Added Reseller Agreement, later followed by an amendment on two-year exclusivity in Poland and registered project exclusivity in Europe. In early March of 2010 Noma2 sent four engineers to the Hie Electronics' facility in Texas for one week of integration/product testing and deployment training. Both companies sent their respective representatives to visit each other's premises and meet the teams and the management.

2) Product Architecture, Capability, and Functionality

In order to meet the rigid legal requirements of the Polish Government statue for mass audience video storage, Noma2 came to a decision that the TeraStack Solution would solve its customer's video data archiving problem (i.e. 12-month Praetorian surveillance video storage for 160 cameras).

3) Praetorian/TeraStack Integration during Training and Initial Test Results

During the onsite training in McKinney, TX the Noma2 and Hie Electronics engineers cooperated closely and succeeded in developing and implementing an application that allows for restoring the recorded data from the TeraStack memory and viewing it with the use of the Praetorian system. The initial test results from integration/product testing were very positive.

4) Final Implementation

In June/July 2010 the solution was fully implemented at the client's site. Onsite implementation/testing problems were resolved as a result of Hie Electronics highly skilled staff, their full commitment and long distance support.

5) Current Status and Team Work

The final system testing has been completed. The deployment of the TeraStack as a storage solution supporting the Praetorian system at the Spodek Arena in Katowice, Poland has been a true success. This has been possible due to the excellent cooperation and effort of both the Noma2 and Hie Electronics engineers.

6) Recommendation

Noma2 recommends the TeraStack Solution as a product fully integrated with the Praetorian system for any projects requiring extended storage. We also compliment Hie Electronics as a company that fully supports its partners in achieving their objectives.
